Clarification of News Report

We refer to your letter dated August 3, 2015 with respect to the news article entitled "Robinsons eyes 70 Costa stores" posted in The Standard (Internet Edition) on July 31, 2015. The article reported in part that:

"Robinsons Retail Holdings Inc., the retail arm of industrialist John Gokongwei, is spending P672 million to build 70 Costa Coffee stores in the Philippines over the next five years.

Costa Coffee general manager Corinne Milagan said in an interview at the sidelines of the opening of Costa Coffee's second branch in the Philippines at Robinsons Place in Ermita, Manila the company would open three more outlets this year in Bonifacio Global City in Taguig, E. Rodriguez Avenue in Quezon City and Robinsons Antipolo in Rizal.

Please be advised that Robinsons Retail Holdings, Inc., through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Robinsons Gourmet Food and Beverage, Inc., plans to open approximately 70 Costa Coffee stores in the Philippines in the next 5 years. The total cost of investment however would depend on the size of the stores to be opened and may also vary depending on certain factors such as costs of equipment, exchange and interest rates.
