There are a lot of beverages to choose from, each handcrafted by skilled baristas who take pride in the technicalities of coffee-making. The signature *Flat White* has an extracted shot of Cortissimo that is then topped with textured milk, resulting in an intense and rich coffee mellowed with a velvety smooth texture. Other bestsellers are Capuccino, Latte, Café Caramella, Mocha and ice-blended Frostinos.
